CLASS DESCRIPTION:

- **Life Skills and Recreation:** We provide comprehensive life skills training, including menu planning, cooking, budgeting, and grocery shopping. Participants engage in physical fitness activities based on their interests and use community resources.
- **Employment and Volunteer Readiness:** We offer a foundation for learning work skills, emphasizing the importance of being a good employee. Our aim is to help participants find meaningful and sustainable employment by collaborating with community partners. Our program also prepares young adults with the skills needed for successful volunteering. We match them with opportunities based on their interests and abilities.
- **Community Awareness and Safety:** We focus on community safety and etiquette, enhancing participants' understanding of belonging to various communities while fostering social relationships and respectful citizenship.
- **Digital Literacy:** We provide digital literacy training, including the use of public transit, digital maps, and navigation apps for Calgary. Our goal is to empower young adults to use technology effectively and confidently.
- **Social Enterprise Development:** We offer in-house opportunities for young adults to create homemade goods and gain experience selling them at local markets.
